Sí. Todos los programas de Asistencia Médica de Pensilvania, la Asistencia Médica de Emergencia, y el programa CHIP cubren las pruebas de COVID-19 sin un copago.

¿Puedo hacerme la prueba si no tengo seguro médico?

Sí. Todos los sitios incluidos en este volante proveen pruebas de COVID-19 gratis a personas sin seguro médico.

¿Cómo puedo solicitar Medicaid?

Solicite por teléfono al 1-866-550-4355, en línea (www.compass.state.pa.us) o en persona en su Oficina de asistencia del condado local.

¿Puedo obtener la prueba si no soy un ciudadano estadounidense?

Sí. Hacerse la prueba de COVID-19 nunca requiere prueba de ciudadanía. Puede obtener la prueba sin importar su estatus migratorio. Los sitios de pruebas frecuentemente piden identificación (ID) para asegurar que los resultados de la prueba lleguen a la persona correcta, pero su información no será compartida afuera de la clínica o sitio de prueba.

Yes. All listed sites provide free COVID-19 testing to people who are uninsured.

Q: How can I apply for Medicaid?

Apply by phone at 1-866-550-4355, online at www.compass.state.pa.us, or in person at your local County Assistance Office (CAO).

Q: Can I get tested if I am not a US citizen?

Yes. Testing for COVID-19 never requires proof of citizenship. You can get tested regardless of your immigration status.

Is COVID-19 testing free if I have Medicaid?

Yes. All Pennsylvania Medical Assistance programs, Emergency Medical Assistance, and CHIP will cover COVID-19 testing without a co-payment.

Can I get tested if I am uninsured?

Yes. All sites listed here provide free COVID-19 testing to people who are uninsured. Check with the site for the most recent information regarding cost.

How can I apply for Medicaid?

Apply by phone at 1-866-550-4355, online at www.compass.state.pa.us, or in person at your local County Assistance Office (CAO).

Can I get tested if I am not a US citizen?

Yes. COVID-19 testing never requires proof of citizenship. You can get tested regardless of your migration status. Test sites often request ID for the purpose of correctly matching test results, but your information will not be shared outside of the test site.
