

# FREE COVID-19 TEST SITES IN WEST PHILADELPHIA

- Monday-Friday 9:00am-12:30pm and 1:00pm-3:30pm
- It is not necessary to be symptomatic in order to be tested

## Spectrum Health Services

- Call 215-471-2761 to make an appointment
- Monday, Wednesday & Friday 9:30am-4:00pm
- It is not necessary to be symptomatic in order to be tested

## Philadelphia Department of Public Health Center 3

- 555 South 43rd Street
- Call 215-685-2933 to make an appointment
- Hours vary; call to schedule testing
- Tests are available for people with symptoms or people who have had contact with a person with symptoms of Covid-19

## Greater Philadelphia Health Action Woodland Ave Health Center

- Call (215) 271-4286 to make an appointment
- Wednesday 3-4:30pm and Saturday when possible
- It is not necessary to be symptomatic in order to be tested

# QUESTIONS

**Can I get a Covid test if I don't have health insurance?**

Yes, at these sites it is not necessary to have insurance in order to be tested, and testing is free for uninsured individuals. Check with the site for the most recent information regarding cost

**Will being tested affect my migration status?**

No, the test is confidential. Test sites often request ID for the purpose of correctly matching test results, but forms of ID other than a driver's license are acceptable (such as a municipal ID or passport) and will not be shared outside of the clinic or test site. In the case of a positive result, participation in contact tracing is voluntary and will never involve sharing sensitive information like your immigration status or social security number.
