

Launch a Facebook Birthday Fundraiser for PHLP!

Step by Step Instructions

- 1. First, make sure you have your birthday listed on Facebook. If you don't want to give Facebook that much information then you're better off starting a general fundraiser not tied to your birthday, which is perfectly fine. Note that every fundraiser is open to the public.
- 2. Go to your Facebook 'home' page, and look on the left side column. Click "Fundraisers". You may need to click "See More" on the list in order to see the Fundraisers option.



3. Click "Select Nonprofit" under "Raise Money for a Nonprofit".



4. Search for and select Pennsylvania Health Law Project from the list in the pop-up.


