

## 2025 Medicare Part D Zero Premium Prescription Drug Plans

In Pennsylvania, all dual eligibles **and** those approved for Extra Help with their Part D costs will have **no premium** if they enroll in either of the plans listed below.

Extra Help works with any Part D plan someone joins. No matter what prescription drug plan someone has, dual eligibles and others with Extra Help pay **no** deductible. Depending on their situation, people will pay the following Part D co-pays with Extra Help in 2025:

- \$0 if someone gets Medicaid-covered long-term services and supports either in a nursing home or through a Home & Community-Based Services Waiver program
- \$1.60/generics and \$4.80/brand names (if getting full Medicaid health coverage and income is <100% FPL)
- \$4.90/generics and \$12.15/brand names (if income is >100% FPL)
